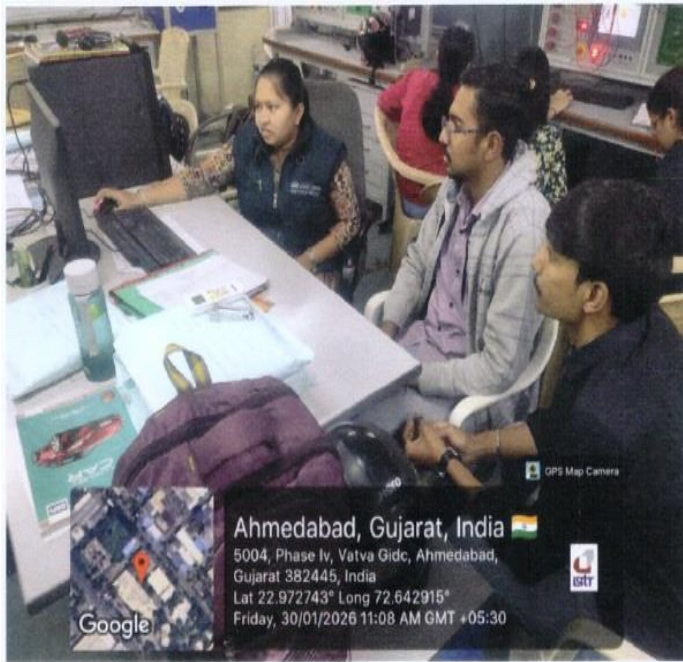

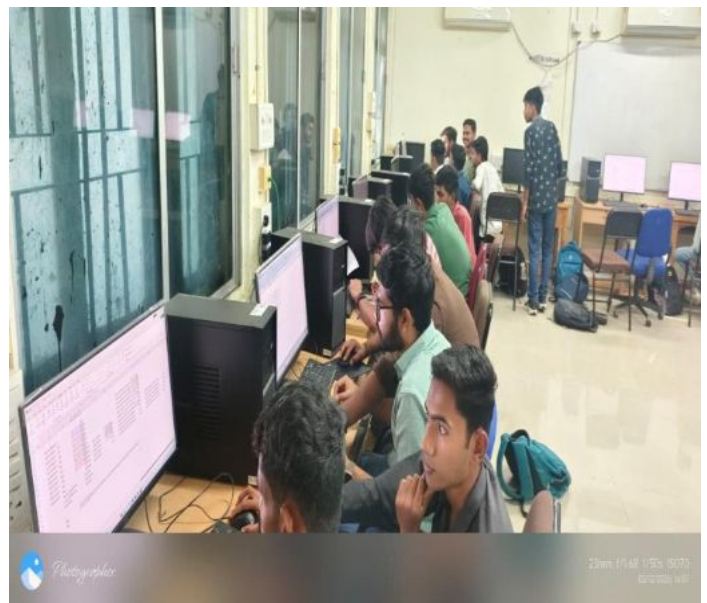
MOU with Adani

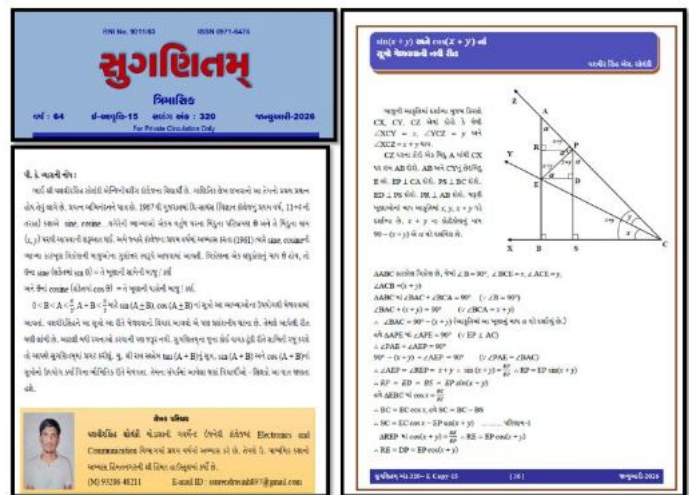

Poetry Writing Competition and securing 1st Rank, on 28/12/2025.

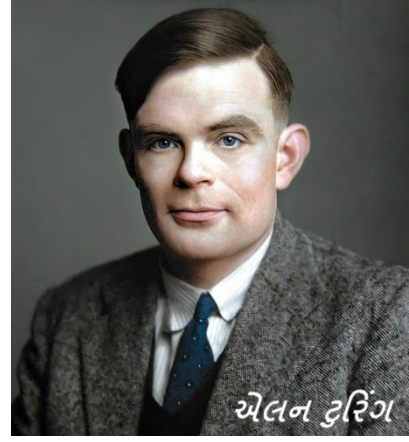

એલન ટ્યુરિંગ : વિજેતાનો વિષાદ અને AI નો ઉદય



મિત્રો તા. 09-03-2026નાં રોજ આપણે સહુએ ટેકનિકલ શિક્ષણ સંચાલક તરફથી આયોજિત આર્ટિફિશિયલ ઇન્ટેલિજન્સ વિષયક વર્કશોપમાં ભાગ લીધો હતો. તેમાં ફેબ્રુઆરી 2026માં દિલ્હી ખાતે યોજાયેલ યોજાયેલ “India AI Impact Summit 2026”ની માહિતી આપવામાં આવેલ. આ ઉપરાંત એક અન્ય રસપ્રદ માહિતી એ હતી કે પહેલી એ.આઈ. સમીટ 2023માં બ્રિટનના “બ્લેચલી પાર્ક” ખાતે યોજાયેલી. તો એક નજર બ્લેચલી પાર્કનાં એ મહાનાયકની જે આર્ટિફિશિયલ ઇન્ટેલિજન્સનાં પિતામહ ગણાય છે. આ ક્ષેત્રના તેઓ એક એવા વિજેતા હતા જેમના પ્રારબ્ધમાં ઘેરો વિષાદયોગ પણ લખાયેલો હતો.

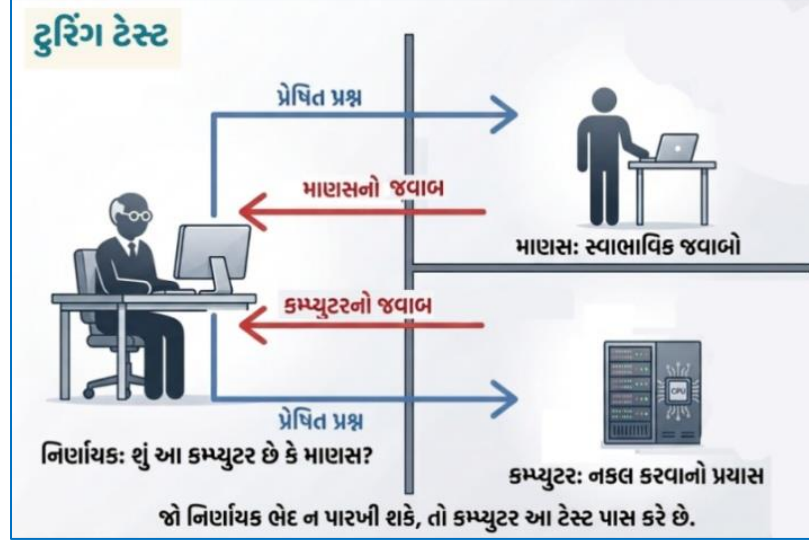
એલનનો જન્મ 23 જૂન 1912ના રોજ લંડનમાં થયો હતો. તેમના પિતા જુલિયસ ટ્યુરિંગ ઇન્ડિયન સિવિલ સર્વિસના અધિકારી હતા. ટ્યુરિંગનો પિંડ ભારતભૂમિ પર બંધાયો હતો અને જન્મ ઇંગ્લેન્ડમાં. કિંગ્સ કોલેજ, કેમ્બ્રિજથી ગણિતમાં સ્નાતક થયા બાદ તેમણે એક પરિકલ્પિત(Hypothetical) ગણનચંત્રની ડિઝાઇન તૈયાર કરી, જે આજે 'ટ્યુરિંગ મશીન' તરીકે ઓળખાય છે. ટ્યુરિંગ મશીનને આધુનિક કોમ્પ્યુટરનો સૈદ્ધાંતિક પાયો માનવામાં આવે છે 1939માં બ્રિટન દ્વિતીય વિશ્વયુદ્ધમાં સપડાઈ ગયું હતું ત્યારે ટ્યુરિંગની નિમણુક બ્લેચલી પાર્ક ખાતે થઈ હતી. દ્વિતીય યુદ્ધ માટે જર્મનીના ભાથામાં અનેક નવા-નવા હથિયાર અને મશીનો હતા. આ પૈકીનું એક મહત્વનું મશીન એટલે “એનિગ્મા(Enigma)”. આ મશીન જર્મન સૈન્યના સંદેશાઓને એવા ગુપ્ત કોડમાં બદલી નાખતું જેને ઉકેલવું લગભગ અશક્ય હતું. એનિગ્માનાં કોડ બ્રેકિંગ માટે બ્રિટને તેનું શ્રેષ્ઠ બુદ્ધિધન એકત્ર કરી તેને ‘બ્લેચલી પાર્ક’માં કામે લગાડ્યું હતું. આ સિક્રેટ મિશનને કોડનેમ આપવામાં આવ્યું હતું ‘પ્રોજેક્ટ અલ્ટ્રા’ અને તેના વડા હતા એલન ટ્યુરિંગ.બ્લેચલી પાર્કમાં અથાગ પ્રયાસો પછી એલનની ટીમે ‘બોમ્બ(Bombe)’ નામનું એક વિશાળ ઇલેક્ટ્રો-મેકેનિકલ મશીન તૈયાર કર્યું હતું. આ ‘બોમ્બ’ સંહારક નહિ ઉધ્ધારક હતો. લગભગ બે વર્ષની મહેનત બાદ એલનની ટીમને કોડ બ્રેક કરવામાં સફળતા મળી ગઈ. આ બહુ જ મોટી સિદ્ધિ હતી. કોઈ સેના નાયક કરતા પણ

મોટી. ઇતિહાસકારો માને છે કે ટુરિંગ અને તેમની ટીમને કારણે કારણે વિશ્વયુદ્ધ બે વર્ષ વહેલું પૂરું થયું અને લાખો લોકોના જીવ બચ્યા. એલન ટુરિંગ આ યુદ્ધના અનામી નાયક (Unsung Hero) હતા.



1950માં ટુરિંગે કોમ્પ્યુટર એક પથદર્શક સંશોધન પત્ર(Research Paper) રજૂ કર્યું. જેનું શીર્ષક હતું "Computing Machinery and Intelligence". આ સંશોધનપત્રને આર્ટિફિશિયલ ઇન્ટેલિજન્સના ઇતિહાસમાં એક ક્રાંતિકારી દસ્તાવેજ માનવામાં આવે છે. એલન ટુરિંગે પોતાના સંશોધન પત્રમાં કમ્પ્યુટર માટે 'ઇમિટેશન ગેમ' નો પ્રસ્તાવ મૂક્યો હતો. આ ગેમ વાસ્તવમાં ઇંગ્લેન્ડની એક લોકપ્રિય પાર્ટી ગેમ પર આધારિત હતી. આ પાર્ટી ગેમમાં ત્રણ પાત્રો હતા: એક પુરુષ, એક સ્ત્રી અને એક જજ/પ્રશ્નકર્તા(Interrogator). જજ બીજા રૂમમાં બેસીને પુરુષ અને સ્ત્રીને ચિઠ્ઠીઓ દ્વારા પ્રશ્નો પૂછતો, તે પુરુષ કે સ્ત્રી કોઈને જોઈ શકતો નહોતો. પુરુષનું કામ જજને છેતરીને એવું માનવા મજબૂર કરવાનું હતું કે તે પોતે 'સ્ત્રી' છે. તે પોતાના જવાબો સ્ત્રી જેવી વિચાર શૈલીથી લખતો. સ્ત્રીનું કામ જજને સાચું ગાઇડ કરવાનું હતું કે, "હું જ અસલી સ્ત્રી છું, પેલો પુરુષ ખોટું બોલે છે." અંતે, જો જજ છેતરાઈ જાય અને પુરુષને સ્ત્રી માની લે, તો પુરુષ ગેમ જીતી જતો, નહીં તો સ્ત્રી. એલન ટુરિંગે પોતાના રિસર્ચ પેપરમાં પ્રશ્ન મૂક્યો: "જો આ રમતમાં પુરુષની જગ્યાએ આપણે કોઈ કમ્પ્યુટર મૂકી દઈએ, તો શું થશે?" જો કમ્પ્યુટર આપણને પ્રતિત કરાવવામાં સફળ રહે કે 'તે માણસ છે' તો તે બુદ્ધિશાળી ગણાય. એટલેકે "આર્ટિફિશિયલ ઇન્ટેલિજન્સ" ધરાવતું ગણાય. એક રસપ્રદ વાત. જ્યારે તમે ઇન્ટરનેટ પર કેપ્ચા(CAPTCHA) કોડ ભરો છો, ત્યારે તમે અજાણતા જ એલન ટ્યુરિંગની યુક્તિનો ઉપયોગ કરી રહ્યા હોવ છો! 'CAPTCHA' એટલે 'Completely Automated Public Turing test to tell Computers and Humans Apart'. કેપ્ચા એ એક "રિવર્સ ટુરિંગ ટેસ્ટ" છે. કેપ્ચામાં જે તે વેબસાઇટ માણસની પરીક્ષા લે છે કે સામે બેઠેલી વ્યક્તિ સાચે જ માણસ છે કે કોઈ હેકિંગ બોટ (સોફ્ટવેર). બોલો છે ને અજબ ઉલટી ગંગા. આપણે રોજ કમ્પ્યુટરને સાબિતી આપવાની કે આપણે માણસ જ છીએ!



જાન્યુઆરી 1952માં એક એવી ઘટના બની જેના કારણે એલન ટુરિંગના જીવનમાં અણધાર્યો મોડ આવ્યો. તેમના માન્ચેસ્ટર સ્થિત ઘરમાં ચોરી થઈ. ટુરિંગે આ ચોરીની ફરિયાદ નોંધાવવા માટે પોલીસનો સંપર્ક કર્યો. ટુરિંગને શંકા હતી કે આ ચોરીમાં તેમનો એક પરિચિત યુવાન આર્નોલ્ડ મરે સામેલ હતો. જ્યારે આ ચોરી અંગેની પૂછપરછ શરૂ થઈ ત્યારે પોલીસને એલન અને આર્નોલ્ડના સજાતીય સંબંધોની જાણ થઈ. તે સમયે બ્રિટનમાં સજાતિયતા કાયદાકીય રીતે ગુનો ગણાતો હતો જેને 'ગ્રોસ ઈન્ડીસન્સી' કહેવામાં આવતું. પોલીસે ચોરીની તપાસ બાજુ પર મૂકી દીધી અને ખુદ એલન ટુરિંગ પર જ કાયદાના ઉલ્લંઘનનો ગુનો નોંધી તેમની ઘરપકડ કરી લીધી. બ્લેચલી પાર્ક ખાતે ટુરિંગનું પ્રદાન ગુપ્તતાનાં લોખંડી પરદાને કારણે કોઈ સરકારી ચોપડે નોંધાયેલું નહોતું. અદાલતે એલનને બે વિકલ્પ આપ્યા: 'જેલની સજા ભોગવો અથવા 'કેમિકલ કેસ્ટ્રેશન' (સ્ત્રી હોર્મોન(એસ્ટ્રોજન)નાં ઇન્જેક્શન) લો'. ટુરિંગે જેલના બદલે ઇન્જેક્શનનો વિકલ્પ પસંદ કર્યો. આ હોર્મોન થેરાપીના કારણે તેમના શરીર અને મન પર ખૂબ જ નકારાત્મક અસરો થઈ. તેમના હાથ ધ્રુજવા લાગ્યા, ચહેરા પર કરચલી વધવા લાગી. જે વ્યક્તિએ વિશ્વને નાઝી અત્યાચારોથી મુક્ત કરાવ્યું હતું, તે હવે ઇન્જેક્શન મારફત ટીપે ટીપે અત્યાચારનાં ડોઝ લઈ રહ્યો હતો. અંતે તેમની ધીરજ અંતે છેહ આપી ગઈ. 1954ના 7 જૂનના દિવસે ફક્ત 41 વર્ષની ઉંમરે એલન ટુરિંગે પોતાનો જીવ ત્યાગી દીધો. સરકારી રિપોર્ટ અનુસાર તેમણે પોટેશીયમ સાઈનાઇડ યુક્ત સફરજન ખાઈને આત્મહત્યા કરી હતી. એલન ટુરિંગની યાતના ફિલ્મ 'ધ ઇમિટેશન ગેમ(2014)'માં આબાદ ઝીલવામાં આવી છે. ટુરિંગ ભલે આજે આપણી વચ્ચે નથી, પણ તેમનો વારસો અમર છે. ટુરિંગે કહ્યું હતું કે 'આ સદીના અંત સુધીમાં આખું જગત એક મશીન પર ચાલતું હશે, જે હશે 'કમ્પ્યુટર'!
