- Have you ever failed or faced academic challenges?
- What did you learn from your college experience?

*Career Goals & Company Interest:*

- Why do you want to join our company?
- What do you know about our company?
- Where do you see yourself in 5 years?
- What are your career goals?
- Why should we hire you instead of others?
- Are you applying to other companies?
- What are your expectations from this job?
- What does success mean to you?

*Strengths, Weaknesses & Personality:*

- What is your greatest achievement?
- Tell me about a failure in your life.
- How do you handle stress and pressure?
- What are your leadership qualities?
- Are you a team player? Give an example.
- How do you handle criticism?
- What is your biggest fear?
- What makes you angry?
- How do you manage your time?

*Situation-Based / Behavioral Questions:*

- Describe a challenging situation you faced and how you handled it.
- Tell me about a time you worked in a team.

- Tell me about a conflict with a teammate.
- Have you ever taken initiative?
- Describe a time you showed leadership.
- How do you prioritize tasks?
- What would you do if you disagreed with your manager?

- Are you willing to relocate?
- Are you comfortable working in shifts?
- What are your salary expectations?
